

Choir Scholarship

The Delaware State University Choir Scholarship recognizes student's achievements and talents in the vocal arts.

Scholarship Awards

\$1,000 to \$4,000 Awards

These scholarships are in addition to any academic awards for which the student may qualify during the academic year. Scholarships are renewable each year, for a maximum of three years, by completing an audition and the attached form.

How to Apply:

Complete the Choir Scholarship Application form and submit it to Dr. Derrick Thompson, Director of Choirs (EH 286).

The deadline to apply for both fall and spring scholarships is by the add/drop period of the requested semester.

Scholarship Details:

Students invited to audition for a scholarship must prepare two contrasting pieces (more details below) and be prepared to interview with a faculty member.

Audition Information:

If your performance requires accompaniment, it is preferred that you bring your own accompanist or a high-quality accompaniment sound file. If you provide accompanist parts at the time of application submission, a staff accompanist will be available.

Prepare two classical or Broadway songs in contrasting nature (style, tempo, mood). Performance in a foreign language for at least one piece is encouraged but not required. Both pieces must be memorized (approximately 6 to 10 minutes total).

Requirements for Scholarship:

- GPA must remain higher than a 2.75 on a 4.0 scale.
- Must be enrolled in courses full-time. If academic probation or suspension occurs, the student may lose their scholarship.
- Must participate in voice lessons and university choir during the entire academic year, receiving a letter grade of "B" or higher.
- Register for MUSP 101: University Choir and MUSP 134, 234, 334, or 434: Applied Voice.
