## Master of Education in Educational Leadership (MEd)

The Educational Leadership master's degree program develops school leaders through new understandings related to leadership models and frameworks that support diverse, inclusive, equitable and safe learning environments. The program encourages academic and personal excellence through rigorous learning experiences in the areas of strategic leadership, ethical and reflective leadership, community leadership and instructional leadership. #### **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

Applicants must either:

- Show evidence of an earned baccalaureate degree at an accredited college or university in an aligned discipline with a minimum undergraduate cumulative grade point average of 3.0, possess the ability to do graduate work of high quality, and meet language proficiency requirements for English (and target language for those pursuing bilingual education); or
- Be a current undergraduate student with senior status with a minimum undergraduate cumulative grade point average of 3.0. Undergraduate applicants may apply during their junior year, and must also submit a letter of recommendation from their advisor in addition to the two required letters of recommendation. Undergraduate admits may complete the TESOL/Bilingual Education course requirements during their senior year, but must complete their bachelor's degree prior to beginning the MEd Educational Leadership coursework.

#### Other requirements:

- Two Letters of Recommendation
- **Statement of Purpose** indicating educational career goals and experience
- TOEFL Score (International applicants without a college degree from a U.S. institution only): Minimum TOEFL score of 90 (iBT), 576 (paper), or an IELTS of 6.5
- Primary Teacher Education Program
   Applicants pursuing K-12 certification (only)
   must have completed, or be concurrently enrolled in, a primary teacher education program.
